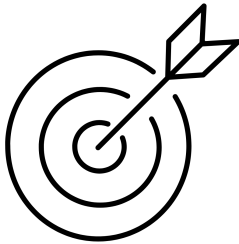

### Our Mission

CARE at the Sexual Assault Resource Center (CARE at SARC) is committed to fostering safety, support and interconnectedness at UC San Diego by providing trauma-informed and survivor-centered services. Guided by the principles of social and healing justice, we strive to empower individuals and promote systemic change through prevention education, advocacy and collaborative efforts that address sexual violence, relationship violence and stalking.



### Our Services

CARE at SARC offers free and confidential support for UC San Diego students, staff and faculty who are impacted by sexual assault, relationship violence and stalking. Services include:

- Survivor Support Services
- Holistic Healing Groups
- Prevention Education and Training
- Consultations





### **Survivor Support Services**

CARE Survivor Support Specialists are certified, confidential professional staff that offer support to survivors, and those supporting survivors, of sexual assault, relationship violence and/or stalking. Services include:

- On-call 24 hours/day, on weekends and on holidays for safety planning and urgent support
- Healing and empowerment peer support groups for survivors
- Case management for academic, housing and employment concerns
- Assistance in navigating police, administrative and non-investigative reporting options
- Accompaniment to police and administrative interviews and court appointments
- Access to medical forensic exams



### **Prevention Education and Training**

CARE staff offer workshops, trainings, and educational events on violence prevention for the entire campus. Services include:

- Custom programs available upon request and trainings offered throughout the year
- Tabling for awareness months, campus events and upon request
- Consultations to coordinate programs, apply violence prevention efforts and on how to support survivors using trauma-informed practices
